## Soft shapes on the table

A table with soft round shapes makes the table highly communicative, allowing everyone around it to speak to each other.

Furthermore a round table seems smaller in the room, as the round shape is more lightweight in its expression. The curved edge also optimizes the surface area of the table, since there are no sharp corners on the table that are optimally utilized.
